- Recruitment: The Wayne County Sheriff's Office is hiring. Learn how to become part of our winning team!

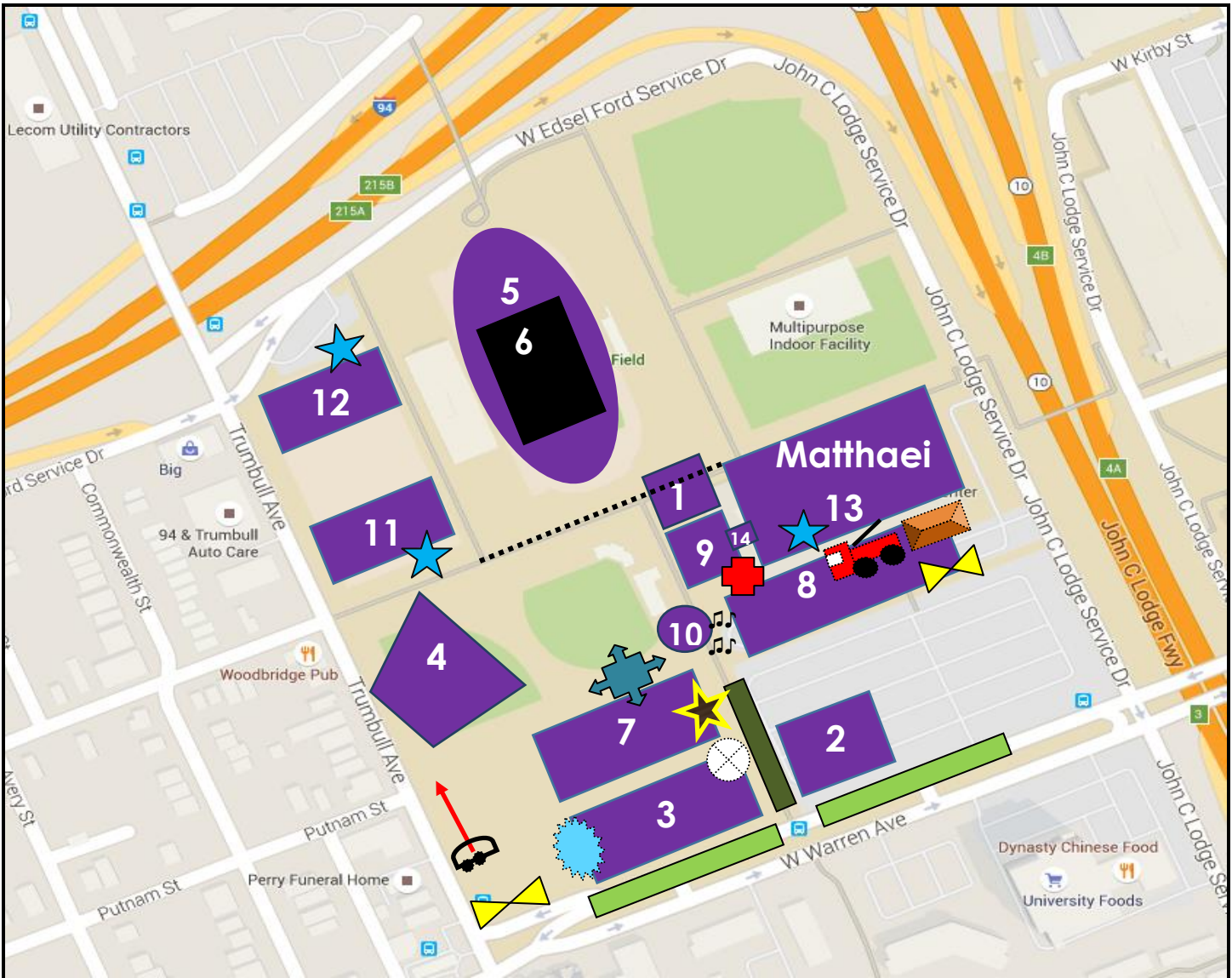

### Remembering Sergeant William Dickerson:

**Sergeant Dickerson Badge #394, a 23-year veteran Wayne County Deputy Sheriff, was killed on September 11, 1991 after rushing to the aid of a fellow officer during an attempted jailbreak. He was the first Wayne County Deputy Sheriff fatally shot in the line of duty since the department was established in 1797.**
