

WCSO TO HELP SEARCH FOR MISSING TODDLER

**Agency deploys nearly two dozen officers to
aid local agencies.**

Wayne County (December 8, 2011) – When local law enforcement officers and volunteers kick off their search for little Bianca Jones today at 11:30 a.m., they'll be assisted by nearly two dozen Wayne County Sheriff's Officers and Investigators. With the toddler missing going on six days now, Sheriff Benny N. Napoleon and other agency officials have deployed as many officers as can be spared from other duties to assist in bringing the child home safely.

“No child should ever be taken away from his or her parent and the people who love them as a result of violence. We want this precious child returned to her home immediately and will do what we can to assist the effort,” said Sheriff Benny N. Napoleon.

The WCS deputies will convene with DPD officials and other volunteers at the designated location on Woodward to kick off today's search. Contact me if you have further questions.
