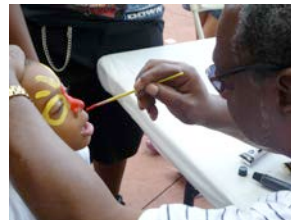

Detroit (August 15, 2012) – Along with fun, prizes and entertainment, Sheriff Benny N. Napoleon's **2nd Annual Wayne County Sheriff Youth and Senior Safety Fair** will offer various educational and safety items to ensure safety in the community and the home.

The fair will be held from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Wednesday, August 22 at the Belle Isle Casino in Detroit. It is sponsored by the Wayne County Sheriff Youth & Senior Education Fund and TRIAD, a nonprofit that promotes senior safety. More than 2,000 seniors and children attended the inaugural event last year.
