WCSO RAIDS SUSPECTED DRUG HOUSE

Investigation nets 2 arrests, illegal narcotics and weapons.

Detroit (February 23, 2013) – Sheriff Benny Napoleon’s push to make Wayne County communities safer shut down a suspected drug house on the city’s west side. Around 4:15 p.m., Wayne County Sheriff’s investigators executed a search warrant at 8027 Stout in Detroit. The raid resulted in:

- 2 men arrested
- 4 long guns confiscated including an AK 47
- 2 handguns
- suspected illegal prescription pills and cocaine
- marijuana

The raid was performed following an undercover investigation based on tips from the community. Officers conducted undercover surveillance confirming suspected narcotics trafficking out of the dwelling.

“Dope houses continue to torment our communities and diminish quality of life for hard-working citizens who just want peace and to live in a safe neighborhood,” said Sheriff Napoleon. “It couldn’t have happened without the help of concerned citizens who cared enough to step up. We’ll continue putting dents in these operations to drive home the message that dope houses won’t be tolerated.”

Officers from the WCSO Narcotics and Morality Unit and Detroit Police conducted this afternoon’s successful operation. **Individuals who want to report drug activity or blind pigs operating in their Wayne County community can call the WCSO tip line at 313-833-3190. The call is anonymous.**
