STATUS OFFENDERS AND THE LAW

MI Public Act 72 of 1987 was passed and signed into law with an effective date of September 1, 1987. PA 72 prohibits police from placing a status offender in locked facilities in most cases, but does not prohibit police from taking a status offender into custody. Locked detention of a status offender in an adult jail, police station, or lock up is only permitted **IF** the juvenile is already under jurisdiction of the Court for an offense which, if committed as an adult, would be a felony.

Based upon the law, the following services will be provided when an individual files a Parent Complaint:

1. An assessment to determine what services will meet the family's needs. A report with recommendations will be completed.
2. Referral to the appropriate Community Resource, i.e., counseling, mentorship, shelters, boot camps, boarding & military schools, Job Corp, etc.

Based upon the law the following services will **NOT** be provided:

1. Removal from the Home
2. Placed in detention
3. Placed on a tether
4. Processed if youth is age 17 or older
5. Youths ages 16 and over will not be processed for Truancy from School unless they are already under Court jurisdiction.

EXPECTATIONS OF THE STATUS OFFENDERS UNIT

1. The length of an assessment is determined by the needs of the clients.
2. During the assessment, a Clinical Probation Officer may do any of the following:
 - a. Provide mediation, facilitate mental health hospitalization, contact protective services, etc.
 - b. Refer the family back to the last attended Mental Health facility if the youth has been recently diagnosed with a mental health disorder and prescribed medication.
 - c. Refer the family back to their local Police precinct if the youth's behaviors are more severe than status offenses, i.e., assaults, stealing, drug trafficking, etc.
 - d. Refer the family back to the school to address educational related problems, i.e., need for IEPC, school social work services, etc.
3. Children will not be placed on the Court's official docket simply based upon the parents' request. Parents must submit proof (documentation) of all resources being exhausted prior to official Court action.
